Subject :—Travelling and other related allowances — Revision of the rates of the—.

READ—

- (i) G.O. No. FD 15 SRP (1) 70, dated 9th February 1970;
- (ii) G.O. No. FD 10 SRS 71, dated 1st February 1971;
- (iii) G.O. No. FD 37 SRP (1) 71, dated 22nd February 1971.

PREAMBLE—

Based on the recommendations of the Mysore Pay Commission and the Official (Pay) Committee constituted thereafter, rates of travelling and other related allowances for Government employees were fixed from 1st January 1971. In view of the sharp increase in the petrol prices and general increase in the cost of living, Government have reviewed the present pattern of travelling and other related allowances.

ORDER No. FD 6 SRP (3) 74, BANGALORE, DATED THE 28TH JUNE, 1974

Government are pleased to direct that with effect from 1st July, 1974, the rates of travelling and other related allowances admissible to Government employees, shall be revised as hereunder. The existing classification of Government employees into six categories for purposes of travelling allowance and other existing provisions relating to travelling and other related allowances shall remain unchanged :

A. Road Journey — Mileage Allowance

(1) Road mileage for Motor cars shall be restricted to employees drawing pay of Rs. 600 and above. This restriction will also apply to Road journeys on transfer. The revised rates of Road mileage for the different categories of Government employees for journeys on duty in their own conveyances shall be as follows :—

Mode of Conveyance	Category of Government employees	Rate of road mileage allowance per Kilometre
Motor Car	I, II and III	(i) 60 paise per KM for the first 100 KMs. (ii) 50 paise per KM for the next 100 KMs. (iii) 40 paise per KM for the remaining distance.
Motor Cycle/ Scooter	I, II, III, IV and V.	(i) 30 paise per KM for the first 100 KMs. (ii) 25 paise per KM for the next 100 KMs. (iii) 20 paise per KM for the remaining distance.
Any other means of Conveyance	I, II, III IV and V. VI.	25 paise per KM. 20 paise per KM.

(2) Mileage Allowance for journeys not involving a change of camp or from headquarters and back to headquarters on the same day shall be subject to a limit of Rs. 50 by motor car and Rs. 25 by motor cycle/scooter.

B. Daily Allowance

(1) The revised rates of Daily Allowance admissible to the several categories of Government employees shall be as follows:—

C. Travelling Allowance on Transfer

(a) Rail Journey — Rates of incidental expenses for rail journeys:

The revised rates of incidental expenses for rail journeys and mileage allowance for carriage of personal effects by road, to Government employees transferred from one station to another shall be as follows:—

(b) Road journey — carriage of personal effects by road on transfer :

D. Taxi charges from Palam Airport to Karnataka Bhavan, New Delhi.

The revised rate of taxi charges from Palam Airport to Karnataka Bhavan, New Delhi, and back, admissible to Government employees visiting Delhi on duty, shall be Rs. 10, subject to fulfilment of the other existing conditions.

E. Conveyance Allowance

The revised rates of Conveyance Allowance admissible to Government employees who own conveyances shall be as follows :—

F. Fixed Travelling Allowance

(1) The revised rates of Fixed Travelling Allowance, admissible to the below-mentioned categories of Government employees, shall be as follows :—

(2) Proposals for revision of Fixed Travelling Allowance now being paid to categories of Government employees not mentioned above will be examined separately. Heads of Departments may send up proposals to Finance Department through the concerned administrative Secretariat Department.

2. Necessary amendments to the Karnataka Civil Services Rules shall be issued separately.

3. Government are pleased to direct that the budget allotment during the current year on account of the allowances sanctioned in this order shall not be increased. The Heads of Departments and controlling officers shall ensure that unnecessary touring is avoided and that the expenditure on Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance, etc., is restricted to available budget provisions.
