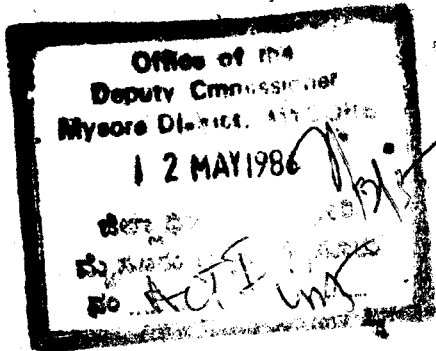

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (2) of Article 283 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Karnataka is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Financial Code, Volume-I, namely:-

1. Title and Commencement: These rules may be called the Karnataka Financial Code, Volume-I (8th Amendment) Rules 1982 and they shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
  2. Amendment to Article 168 (b)(ii) of Karnataka Financial Code, Volume-I (Page 187): Insert the following Note below sub-clause (ii) of Clause (b) article 168 of the Karnataka Financial Code, Volume-I:

"NOTE:- Advertisement in news papers for disposal of Articles and empty bottles, containers etc. shall be inserted only when the amount expected to be realised by sale in public auction of condemned stores, is more than Rs.2,500/-. In other cases, local quotations may be called for from three or more known firms and also published in the office notice board. However, in respect Public Works Department and Irrigation Department the procedure prescribed in Karnataka Public Works Departmental code and Departmental Rules shall be followed".
