P R E A M B L E:-

The Rules under Appendix-IV of the Manual of Contingent Expenditure and the existing orders regulate the scale and pattern of uniforms to be supplied to all eligible Group-D employees working in various Government offices including the Class-IV Government servants who are borne on the Karnataka Government Secretariat (including Government Houses and Guest Houses) and High Court establishments and the Karnataka Public Service Commission Offices.

In the Government Order read at (i) above the revised scale and pattern of supply of uniforms to Group-D employees in the Karnataka Government Secretariat was laid down.

In the Government Order read at (ii) above sanction was accorded for the supply of Uniforms to lady dalayats in the State Government Offices.

In the Government Order read (iii) above the benefit of free supply of uniforms was extended to lady Sweepers/Scavengers in the same pattern and scale and periodicity as applicable to lady dalayats.

The Karnataka State Government Group-D employees Association had been representing to Government for supply of Terrycot uniforms to Group "D" employees in the State, stating that the Cotton uniforms hitherto being supplied do not last long and do not give a good appearance and that the Drivers of Government vehicles have been supplied with Terrycot Uniforms.

ORDER NO. FD 4 TCE 84, BANGALORE DATED THE 30TH JANUARY 1985

The demands of the Karnataka State Government Group-D employees Association have been examined by the Government. Government are now pleased to prescribe the revised scale and pattern of the items of uniforms indicated below to Group-D employees working in various Government offices in the State including Group-D employees of the Karnataka Government Secretariat, Hospitality Organisations as detailed below:
