OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM

Sub:- rationalisation of scale and pattern of uniforms and liveries supplied to group-D employees in the State - clarification.

In the Government Order NO.FD 4 TCE 84, dated 30th January 1985 Government prescribed the revised scale and pattern of the items of uniforms supplied to group-D employees working in various Government offices in the State.

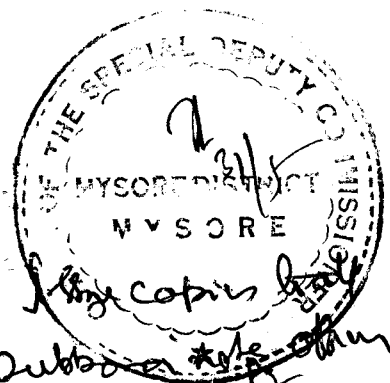
2. Subsequent to the issue of the above Government order some of the Departments of Government have sought clarification on the following:-
(i) whether shoes and socks can be supplied to those Government employees who have already been supplied with uniforms as per the old pattern, (ii) whether the group-D employees can be supplied with terrycot uniforms before the expiry of the periodicity of the uniforms already supplied; & (iii) whether group-D employees such as attenders, mutchies are eligible for the free supply of uniforms.

3. The various points raised by the Government Departments have been examined. In addition to the guidelines already given in the Government order dated 30.1.1985 the following clarifications are given to enable the Government offices to supply uniforms to group-D employees:-

- (1) No group-D employee is eligible for free supply of items of uniforms in the revised scale and pattern unless the periodicity of the uniforms already supplied to him under the existing scale and pattern is over;
- (2) Only those group-D employees who are eligible for free supply of uniforms as per Appendix-IV of the Manual of Contingent Expenditure shall be supplied with uniforms in accordance with the G.O. dated 30.1.1985 and not others;

- (3) The shoes, socks and chappals to be supplied to the Group-D Employees as per the revised scale and pattern shall be purchased only from the Karnataka Leather Industries Development Corporation Limited (LIDKAR) within the maximum rate prescribed in the Govt. order dated 30.1.1985, without referring to stores purchase department as LIDKAR is a Government Company. It is left to the discretion of the heads of offices to purchase and supply the LIDKAR shoes/chappals of convenient variety and having the superior quality subject to maximum rate fixed.
