PREAMBLE:

In the Government Order read at (1) above sanction was accorded for the supply of the uniforms to the Drivers of the Government vehicles in the revised scale and pattern indicated therein.

In the Government Order read at (2) above Government was pleased to prescribe revised scale and pattern of the items of uniforms to Group-D employees working in various Government offices in the State including employees of the Karnataka Government Secretariat, Hospitality Organisation and others. In the said Government Order the periodicity and maximum rate in respect of each item of uniform was also specified.

Stenals

In the Government Order dated 24.6.1983 while sanctioning the revised scale and pattern of uniforms to the Drivers of the Government vehicles it was stated that the revised scale and pattern of supply of uniforms will not apply to Drivers of heavy transport vehicles like Trucks, Tractors, Road Rollers, Bulldozers and similar types of vehicles belonging to Government Departments concerned.

The Karnataka Government Motor Drivers' Central Association, has represented to the Government with a request to supply uniforms to Drivers of heavy transport vehicles also and to provide the rates at which the cloth etc., could be purchased for supply of uniforms to Drivers, as done in the case of Group-'D' employees

ORDER No.FD 7 TCE 85, BANGALORE DATED THE 29TH OCTOBER 1985

In supersession of the Government Order dated 24th June 1983 Government are now pleased to prescribe the revised scale and pattern of the items of uniforms indicated

below to Drivers of Government vehicles of all Government Departments including the Drivers of Karnataka Government Secretariat, High Court, Karnataka Public Service Commission and Hospitality Organisations:-

3) Terrycot shirt with half sleeves (khaki) measuring 1.8 metres.	One	Once in two years	Rs.30 per metre
4) Terrycot trouser (khaki) measuring 1.2 metres.	One	Once in two years	Rs.55 per metre
5) Woollen suit (coarse dark blue) measuring 3 metres.	One set	Once in three years	Rs.150 per metre
6) Woollen jersey	One	Once in three years	Rs.125 per piece
7) Shoes	One pair	Once in a year	Rs.90 per pair
8) Socks	Two pairs	Once in a year	Rs.10 per pair
<u>DRIVERS OF HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLES</u>			
1) Khaki suits (mill made cotton) and each set made up of Bush Shirt measuring 3 metres and Trousers 3 metres.	Three sets	Once in two years	Rs.12 per metre
2) Shoes	One pair	Once in a year	Rs.90 per pair
3) Socks	Two pairs	Once in a year	Rs.10 per pair

The shoes to be supplied will be of superior quality manufactured by LIDKAR.

Other items such as Gold Lace Shamala Kulla, Petta and Caps as already prescribed in the Manual of Contingent Expenditure and other Government Orders for Drivers of specified Government offices (viz., Karnataka Government Secretariat, High Court and the Hospitality Organisations shall be continued to be supplied as hitherto as per existing scale and pattern.

Where a separate scale and pattern has been provided for uniformed personnel like Drivers of vehicles of Police, Fire Force etc., the orders issued in this respect by the respective Departments will apply. And where separate scale and pattern etc., have been prescribed for supply of uniforms to the Drivers of Transport vehicles of Government such as Lorries of P.W.D., Forest Department etc., the orders issued in this respect by the respective Departments will apply.

The Articles of clothing etc., sanctioned in this Order must be purchased in bulk from the firms which have entered into rate contract with the Stores Purchase Department. The Departments, which have a large number of Drivers should approach Stores Purchase Department for fixing such rate contracts. In Department/Offices requiring small quantities occasionally the purchase of clothing etc., should be made in accordance with the Stores Purchase Department rules and the cost thereof should be met from the sanctioned grants for office expenses.

The revised scale and pattern of supply of uniforms will come into force from the date of issue of this order, subject to the condition that the supply of uniforms under the revised scale and pattern would accrue after the expiry of the periodicity of the uniforms already supplied under the existing rules.
