Sub: Investment of the arrears of interim relief and DA in NSC VI Issue.

According to G.O.No.FD 36 SRP 85 dated 27.7.1985, the arrears of the Interim Relief which are payable for the period August 1985 to February 1986 (both months inclusive) are required to be invested in the National Savings Certificates - VI Issue before the 3rd of every month.

2. According to G.O.No.FD 53 SRP 85 dated 4.10.1985, the arrears of the DA increase from May 1985 to October 1985 (both months inclusive) are also required to be invested in the National Savings Certificates - VI Issue before December 1985.

3. The investment of the arrears of the interim relief and dearness allowance in the NSC VI Issue is to be done in multiples of Rs.10/-, the amount, if any, being less than Rs.10/- being paid in cash.

4. The postal authorities have now informed that the printing of National Savings Certificates VI Issue of Rs.10/- denomination has been stopped and hence it is not possible to issue NSC Certificates of Rs.10/- denomination.

5. In view of the stoppage of printing of NSC Certificates of Rs.10/- denomination, Government direct that the investment of the DA arrears for the period - May 1985 to October 1985 (both months inclusive) together with the arrears of the interim relief for the period - August 1985 to November 1985 (both months inclusive) should be made in the NSC VI Issue in multiples of Rs.50/- before 31st December 1985. If any amount falling short of Rs.50/- remains after such investment, this should be invested in March 1986, along with the arrears of interim relief referred to in para 6 below.

6. The arrears of interim relief to be invested in the NSC VI Issue for the period - December 1985 to February 1986 (both months inclusive) should be drawn and invested in NSC VI Issue in multiples of Rs.50/- in March 1986. Thereafter the amount falling short of Rs.50/- may be paid in cash to the employees.
