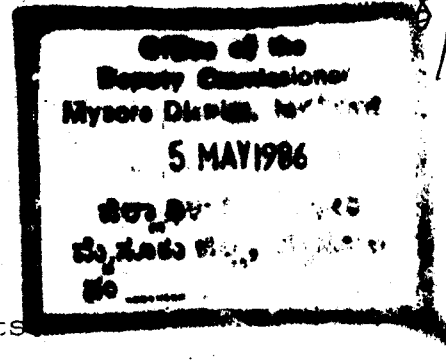

The Government of India, has constituted a committee to review the existing General Financial Rules, Treasury Rules and Accounts Code Volume-I which are common to States and the Central Government and to make conceptual suggestions for their revision so as to:-

- (i) Simplify and rationalise the rules with a view to
 - enhancing their comprehensibility
 - minimising the difficulties of interpretation,
 - reducing paper work and
 - facilitating their smooth application and operation.
- (ii) Bring the rules in line with modern system and procedure and to provide for arrangements to meet the requirements of computerised accounts wherever necessary.
