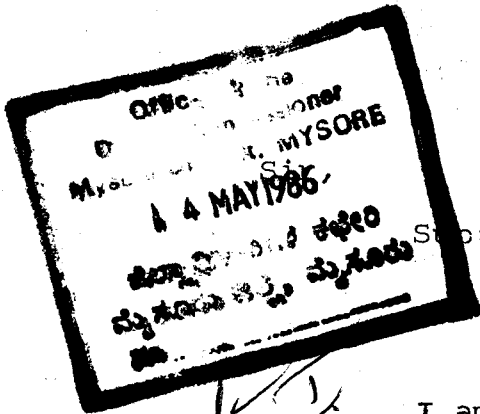

I am directed to invite reference to the Government letters No. FD 20 TAR 83 dated 20th December 1983 and dated 19th July 1984 on the above subject wherein you were requested to round off all the transactions (mentioned in the Government Of India's letter No. F.1/8/82/Coin dated 10th November 1983 enclosed thereto) pertaining to your Department to the nearest multiple of 5 paise. These instructions had also been published in the Karnataka Gazette dated 26.7.1984 (copies of the aforesaid Government letters dated 20.12.1983, 19.7.1984 and their enclosures are enclosed herewith for reference)


It has come to the notice of Government that the instructions contained in the aforesaid letters are still not being followed by some Departments/Organisations and transactions continue to be made in multiple of 1 paise, 2 paise and 3 paise. In fact, Government of India has also complained about non-compliance of these instructions.

I am, therefore, to request you once again to see that all transactions of your Department (e.g., fees/taxes/levies/fixation of prices of essential commodities/materials/manufactured articles/services/banks and insurance transactions/ fares collectible by the Government etc.) are rounded off to the nearest multiple of 5 paise, without fail.

Action taken in the matter may be intimated to Government.
