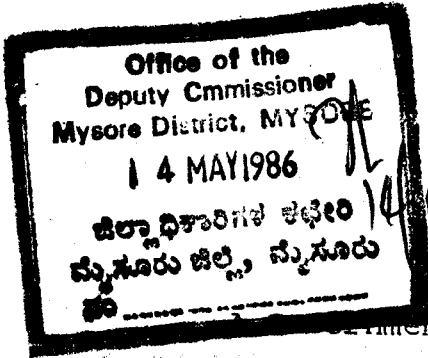

Sub: Regulation of interim relief  
during leave and suspension.

Ref: i) Your D.O.letter No.GM/Genl.

endorsed to all Heads of  
Departments.

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Government servant who is on Earned leave/Commuted leave/Half pay leave is entitled to leave salary in accordance with the provisions of Rule 118 of KCSRs. According to Note below sub-rule (1) of the above mentioned rule, 'pay' for the purpose of leave salary means the pay as defined in rule 8(32) of KCSRs and the rate at which it is admissible before the date of commencement of leave. Interim Relief is calculated on Basic pay. As clarified in Government letter No.FD 2328/PRC&S-II/85 dt.23.8.1985, basic pay for the purpose of calculation of interim relief includes - stagnation increment, additional increment granted above the maximum of the time-scale of pay under Rule 6 of KCS (Service & Kannada Language Examinations) Rules 1974 and Personal Pay allowed under sub-rule (4) of Rule 8 of KCS (Revised Pay) Rules 1982. Interim Relief is payable on the amount of basic pay included in the leave salary, subject to the condition that the arrears for the period 1.8.1985 to 28.2.1986 are invested in the NSC VI Issue.

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A Government servant who is placed under suspension is not entitled to interim relief for the period of suspension.
