3	Brief Description about the Department	<p>The Agricultural Produce Market Committee Mysore is one of the most important Market Committee in the state of Karnataka . Mysore city is a famous tourist centre and is about 140 k.m. away from Bangalore. The city enjoys a good network of Railways and other transport facilities . These factors add to the potentiality of this Market. It is both a Primary and a Secondary Market.</p> <p>ESTABLISHMENT: This Market committee was established on dt: 09-01-50.</p> <p>MARKET AREA: The whole of Mysore taluk is the market area for this Market Committee as declared by Government in the notification No.A & F 6109 market 2648-49 dated 05-04-1949.</p> <p>MARKET: The Mysore city corporation limit, Mysore Kasaba village Panchayat, Chamundi village Panchayath,and Bandipalya village</p>

Panchayat has been declared as MARKET vide notification No.SMD 21 RGN 94 dated 17-01-1996 and amendment dt: 7-2-1996 and 22-3-1996.

MARKET YARD:

An area comprising of 159 ½ acres of Bandipalya village panchayat has been declared as “MARKET YARD” vide notification No.SMD 21 RGN 94 dated 7-2-96 and 20-3-96.

An area of 12 acres situated in Sayyaji Rao Road has been declared as market sub- yard for marketing of vegetables.

DISTRIBUTION OF SITES IN THE MARKET YARD:-

The Market Committee has formed sites and has distributed to the Market functionaries in Bandipalya main Market Yard .

METHOD OF SALE:

The sale of commodities like, groundnut, gingely, sunflower and other food grains in the Bandipalya main Market yard is by tender system. The sale in respect of vegetables is through open auction . The tender of commodities has been computerized since July-2004. With Co-ordination of National Informatic Center(NIC) ,Bangalore E-tendering system has come into existence. The rates of the commodities are being widely publicised through Public Address Systems.

AMENITIES PROVIDED FOR FARMERS:

Farmers who bring their Agricultural Produces to the Market Yard have been provided with well planned Auction Platforms, Drying Platforms , Roads , Drainages, Drinking water facilities , Farmer`s rest house , Canteen, Tea stalls, Toilets, Shady trees , Bank facilities(M.D.C.C.& M.C.C. Banks) . Nationalised Banks and Post Office are expected to be established shortly. A separate Police outpost has been established during 2001. For correct and accurate weighment of agricultural commodities , Electronic Weighing Scales have been installed in Auction platforms and an Electronic Weighbridge has been established in Market Yard for bulk weighments.

MARKET COMMITTEE :

Presently the Elected Committee is functioning from dt: 08-08-2005. Sri C.N.Manjegowdais as President , Sri T.Sampathkumar is as Vice President of the Committee.

MARKET INTELLIGENCE:

As a part of market intelligence day-to-day market rates is being displayed on the notice board, published in daily news-papers and broadcast through All India Radio and also through Internet.

WEIGHMENT :

Only licenced weighmen are permitted to weigh the produces in the market yard. Weighment charges is collected as per the rates fixed in the bye-laws.

MODE OF PAYMENT:

Immediately after the weighment the sellers are paid the value of the produce by the commission agents. The commission agents are permitted to deduct the commission not exceeding 2% for food grains and 5% for vegetables from buyers only.

4 Schemes/Plans benefiting to the public with details (Precise in nature)

For the welfare of farmers , a scheme called **“Raitha Sanjivini”** has been introduced for those who met with accidents during Agricultural activities. Rs. 50,000-00 will be paid to the dependents of those who lost their lives and compensations will be paid to those who have lost their limbs and eyes .

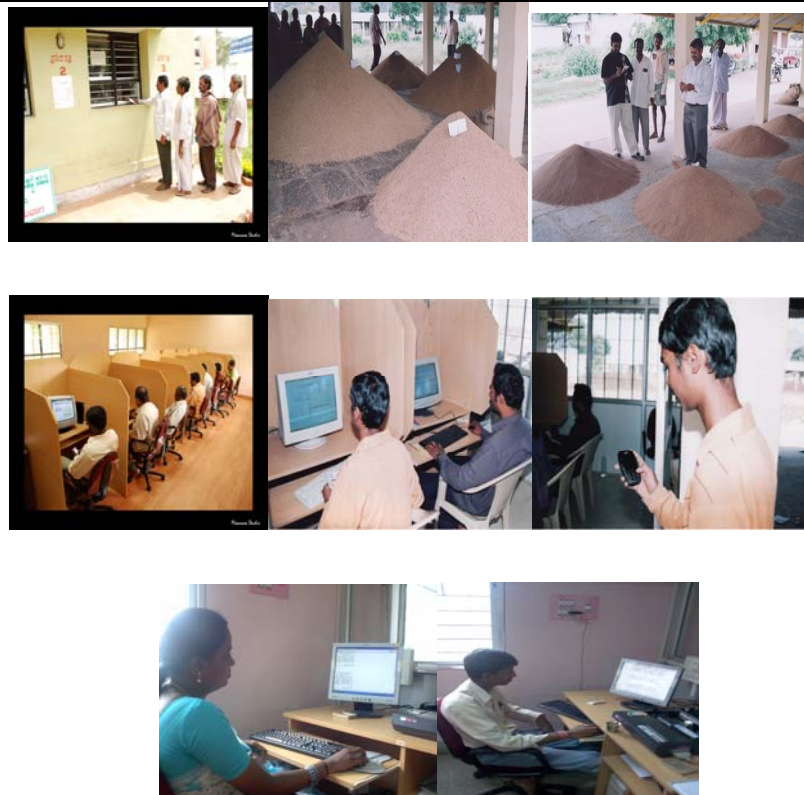

Licenced Hamals have been provided with various benefits such as **“Hamal’s Housing Scheme”** wherein 120 houses have been built with all basic facilities and out of which 115 houses have been allotted to eligible Hamals. For the welfare of Hamals and Weighmen , a scheme called **“Janashree Insurance Scheme”** has been introduced and for the benefit of Hamals and weighmen **“Shramik Bhavan”** has been built in the Market Yard.

5 Important Events

Electronic Tender System was introduced in this Market Yard during the year 2006-07 in the month of August. This is a Pivotal Service extended towards Farmers and Traders. It excellently running every day for the purpose of scientific way of sale in this yard.
